DECLARATION OF MEMBER OF COPELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF  
PECUNIARY AND OTHER REGISTRABLE INTERESTS  
LOCALISM ACT 2011, SECTION 22 & 23  
The relevant statutory provisions are: Financial Interest Regulations  
2012

In order to comply with the regulations through Council's Code of Conduct, a  
Member or Councillor must register their pecuniary and interests  
other than pecuniary interests with the Council's Monitoring Officer within 28  
days of the date of their election or re-election. Failure to declare a  
registrable pecuniary interest is a criminal offence.

Note: (1) Member must, within 28 days of becoming aware of any new  
registrable interest or change to any registrable interest specified above, complete  
details of that new interest (change) or change by completing a new Register  
of Interest Form and submitting it to the Council's Monitoring Officer.

Registrable Interests - This declaration is to be submitted to the Council's Monitoring Officer  
personally sign the completed form.
