#### **ERWP 08/11 Request to Rename Beckermeth Parish Council**

The Working Party considered a request from Beckermeth Parish Council to change their name following a community governance review where the parish now incorporates Thornhill. The proposed name was 'Beckermeth with Thornhill Parish Council'.

**RESOLVED** – that the Working Party support the request and this be forwarded to Full Council with a recommendation that the name of 'Beckermeth Parish Council' be changed to 'Beckermeth with Thornhill Parish Council'.

#### **ERWP 09/11 Draft Recommendations on the New Electoral Arrangements for Cumbria County Council**

Consideration was given to the draft recommendations on the new Electoral arrangements for Cumbria County Council.

Members were advised that the proposal had been widely advertised and comments had been received from three Town Councils, which would be forwarded as part of the consultation response.

In addition, Councillor Tyson thought the proposed 'Woodhouse' division was an inappropriate name for the area it was to represent and suggested the 'Kells and Sandwith' name should remain.

**RESOLVED** – that the comments received from the Town Councils, together with the name 'Kells and Sandwith' for the proposed 'Woodhouse' division be submitted as part of the consultation on the draft recommendations on the new Electoral arrangements for Cumbria County Council.
