Summary The purpose of this report is to present recommendations (contained in

Appendix A attached), for consideration by the Working Party on

changes to polling districts and polling places.

1.0 Recommendations

1.1 That the proposed changes to polling districts and polling places, contained in Appendix A to this report, be approved.

2.0 Background and Proposals

2.1 Under the Representation of the People Act 1983, which provides the steps to be taken, the Council has a duty to divide the District into polling districts, with each parish being a separate polling district, and to designate a polling place for each of these polling districts. This authority rests with the Council and the Returning Officer then has a duty to provide a polling station within each of the identified polling places as far as possible.

Section 16 of the Electoral Administration Act 2006 introduced a number of changes to the 1983 Act, including the requirement for Council to review UK Parliamentary polling districts and polling place arrangements at least every four years. The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 introduced a change to the timing of such reviews, with the next compulsory review to be started and completed between 1 October 2013 and 31 January 2015 (inclusive). Subsequent compulsory reviews must be started and completed within the period of 16 months that starts on 1 October of every fifth year after 1 October 2013.

2.2 The Registration Officer must ensure that the polling district codes remain unique across the parliamentary constituency. If two electors are in the same parliamentary constituency, despite being in two separate authorities, they should have distinct elector numbers. There are now instances where we have duplications between Copeland and Allerdale's polling districts that make up the Copeland Constituency. It is therefore proposed all our polling districts be renamed, alphabetically then numerically by ward, details can be found in the Schedule attached at Appendix A.

- 2.3 There are currently 129 polling districts in Copeland, it is proposed that this is reduced to 103 by merging some of the smaller polling districts together. Details can be found in the Schedule attached at Appendix A.
- 2.4 No changes to polling stations are proposed as a result of this review, but to note that there may be changes to any polling station before the Elections scheduled to take place on 7 May 2015.

3 CONSULTATION

- 3.1 The review was undertaken in accordance with the relevant legislation and the Electoral Commission's guidance document 'Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations' and commenced on 20 June 2014 with the publication of the formal Notice.
- 3.2 The consultation periods ran from 23 June to 1 August 2014 and 18 August to 3 October 2014, with parish councils, councillors and the general public provided the opportunity to comment on the proposals for the electoral arrangements for their parish or parishes.
- 3.3 Seven responses were received during the consultation periods.
- 3.4 Four responses requested 'no change' to the current arrangements and were received from Gosforth Parish Council, Ponsonby Parish Council, Drigg & Carleton Parish Council and Egremont Town Council.
- 3.5 A response from Waberthwaite Parish Council was received in support of the initial proposals.
- 3.6 Responses were received from the Chairman of the Copeland Disability Forum and the Secretary of South Copeland Disability Group. Both highlighted concerns over the use of polling stations that do not provided suitable access for all electors. There are a small number of private houses which are currently used as polling stations and also, there are some polling stations in the more rural areas of Copeland which are not accessible.
- 3.7 Although this review has not resulted in any changes being put forward to these polling stations, all polling station will be kept under constant review to endeavour to improve the voter experience.

4.0 ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS

4.1 The working party can decide not to implement the recommendations contained in this report

5 CONCLUSION

5.1 Any changes approved will be implemented on 1 December 2014.

Polling Districts & Polling Places Review

Background

Within each local authority area, legislation requires councils to carry out reviews of the Polling Districts and Polling Places in that area. The recent Electoral Registration & Administration Act 2013 changed the timing of these reviews and the next review must be held between 1 October 2013 and 31 January 2015 with subsequent reviews held within a 16 month period starting on 1 October every fifth year after 1 October 2013.

This Council's last review was held in 2011 which resulted in no changes being made.

A council's area is divided into polling districts, with one or more polling districts making up a district ward, with a polling place being an area or building within a polling district in which a polling station is situated. Consequently, it is inevitable that polling stations are also considered as part of these reviews.

These reviews are based on council areas or parliamentary constituencies and, consequently, it is imperative that the views of the (Acting) Returning Officer are sought and considered.

The Review in Copeland

Polling districts, polling places and polling stations will be considered and this Review will take into account the following:-

- The position and size of the polling place and whether it is appropriate for the polling district and provides sufficient flexibility;
- The availability of postal votes on demand; and
- The suitability of a polling station with regard to:
 - o Accessibility and effectiveness for the majority of the voters in the polling district;
 - o Facilities for voters and, in particular, for those with a disability; and
 - Whether the premises provide economic efficiency with regard to the number of personal voters allocated at a polling station, in particular if they have less than 100 electors voting in person.
