SH 01 Appointment of Chairman

SH 02 Minutes

SH 03 <u>Declarations of Personal and Prejudicial Interests</u>

SH 04 <u>Copeland Homes Steering Group – Membership and Terms of Reference</u>

Consideration was given to the proposed terms of reference for the Copeland Homes Joint Steering Group (JSG) set up in succession to the Copeland Homes Board.

During consideration of this item Members asked for the Liaison Group to be re-established and it was noted that this was in the process of being done and it was anticipated that it would meet quarterly.
