SH 49 Draft Housing Services Standards

Following a criticism from the Audit Housing Inspectorate over the absence of published housing services standards, consideration was given to the first draft of the proposed document.

During consideration of this item members stressed the importance of not only having the document but the fact that it had to be achievable, officers assured them that they felt that the document was achievable.

Members further asked if the possibility of having surgeries in other areas of the Borough such as Cleator Moor, Egremont and Millom. It was agreed that this would be looked into and reported back but should not hinder the delivery of this document.

SH 50 Draft Private Sector Housing Regulation & Enforcement Policy

In accordance with the compliance with the Regulators Compliance code the Council must publish an explicit enforcement policy for its services. This code applies to those parts of the Housing Act 1985, 1996 and 2004 that refer to the Council's role in the private housing sector.

Consideration was given to the first draft of the document prior to further consultation. During consideration of this item members endorsed the importance of publicising what the Council does and be strong in order to help people.
