Copeland Core Strategy and Development Management Policies 2012 – 2027

The Core Strategy will be the development strategy for Copeland. Replacing the Local Plan adopted in 2006, it will provide the planning framework for guiding development in the Borough for fifteen years. It covers the whole Borough and includes a spatial strategy governing where most development should be, along with key strategic policies for the economy, community development and nurturing the environment.

It is accompanied by development management policies which will be used to determine planning applications in the plan period.
