Seascale Parish Council feels that:

- 1. The capacity of Seascale Primary School has not been adequately addressed;
- 2. The current poor quality of road and rail infrastructure should be further considered, and the results of the traffic survey commissioned by Cumbria County Council in July 2012 should be recognised and incorporated into the core strategy;
- 3. The flooding risk in the area of Cringley Stream and the Poly Beck is currently underestimated. The floods of 30-31 August 2012 emphasise the importance of this concern;
- 4. The core strategy suffers from the poor quality of maps and the location of the Seascale Community Plan in the West Copeland section rather than the Mid Copeland section;
- 5. Section 8.6.2 (origins of Seascale) should be developed more fully;
- 6. Section 8.6.4 (Seascale's role as the largest service centre in the locality) should be clarified to reflect Seascale more effectively;
- 7. Section 8.6.8 (bus service provision) should be checked and found to be factually accurate.
