INTRODUCTION

As a result of the NDA's plans to tender the competition for the LLWR, the Council has agreed with the NDA that a document aimed at providing guidance to the contractor on the local community could form part of the tender process. Therefore local community prospectus will form part of the overall tender documentation for the waste management contract. It will act as an aid to inform the contractor on the following:
