1.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION

1.1 11 Market Place, Egremont

1.1.1 Planning permission was granted for "conversion of attached vacant shop to domestic accommodation" on 15 August 2003. Condition 2 of the approval required that:-

"Detailed plans of any proposed external alterations to the premises shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority before such development is commenced".

- 1.1.2 External alterations were subsequently undertaken other than in accordance with the approved plans and an Enforcement Notice was served.
- 1.1.3 A subsequent appeal has been ALLOWED. A copy of the Inspector's decision letter is appended to this report.

1.2 Whinnah, Lamplugh

1.2.1 An application for outline planning permission for a single storey dwelling was refused on 20 July 2005 for the following reason:-

"It is considered that the applicant's housing need can be adequately met elsewhere in the locality. As such the proposal is considered to represent a form of non-essential housing development in the countryside contrary to Policy HSG 5 of the Copeland Local Plan 2001-2016 2nd Deposit Version".

1.2.2 A subsequent appeal against this decision has been DISMISSED. A copy of the Inspector's decision letter is appended to this report.
