

**STREET NAMING AND NUMBERING  
NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT – LAND ADJACENT TO LINGLA BANK,  
FRIZINGTON**

<p><b>To ask members to decide on the street name for the proposed new housing development, site adjacent to Lingla Bank, Frizington</b></p>
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**Recommendation:** That the street name **LINGLA GARDENS** be adopted for the housing development and all the relevant bodies be notified.

**Resources Implications:** Cost of providing street nameplates if the request is approved.

**1.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION**

- 1.1. The site is a development accessed via Lingla Road,
- 1.2 The developer does not wish to extend the numbering of Lingla Bank, but seeks to provide a separate street name for their development.
- 1.3 The developer has suggested **LINGLA GARDENS** and **LINGLA CLOSE** for the development. However, as the development is not a cul-de-sac **LINGLA GARDENS** seems the most appropriate.
- 1.4 Arlecdon and Frizington Parish Council have been consulted and have suggested the name **CROSSLACON CLOSE** which they feel reflects the history of the area. Crosslacon being amongst other things, the name of a quarry located nearby. However, the developer is not in favour of this name.
