#### C 124 Mayor's Announcements

The Mayor welcomed Councillor Mrs J Williams to the first meeting of the Council since her election.

The Mayor then referred to the various engagements she had attended since the last meeting of Council.

Finally the Mayor reminded Members that her Charity Ball would be held on Friday 12 October in aid of her charities and that all donations would be welcomed.

# C 125 Executive Report

## C 126 West Lakes Renaissance Auditing and Verification Procedures

Arising from the Achieving Transformation Executive Report and in response to a question from Councillor C J Whiteside on auditing and verification procedures for grant funding of local projects by West Lakes Renaissance, Councillor Williams agreed to provide a written reply to Councillor Whiteside.

## C 127 Rural Waste Collection
