PROPOSED CREATION OF BRIDLEWAY AT BIGERT MIRE, PARISH OF ULPHA

I am writing to you about the public bridleway that crosses Waberthwaite Fell from Bigert Mire, in the parish of Ulpha to Fell Lane, in the parish of Waberthwaite. I originally consulted about a proposed bridleway creation order at the western end of the bridleway, Fell Lane, in August of this year. From the comments that I received back, it was suggested that we correct an anomaly at the eastern end of the bridleway at the same time.

Please find enclosed a plan showing public bridleway 427022, Bigert Mire, stopping one hundred metres short of the public road U4085. Users of the bridleway have been using the proposed creation route A-B as if it were a public bridleway. We would like to formalise the situation of people using a route with no recorded rights along it. We intend to make a bridleway creation order for Bigert Mire at the same time as making a bridleway creation order for Fell Lane.

We are considering if this bridleway is needed for public use. Before we take any decision I would be grateful for your views so that your comments can be taken into consideration.

A response by Friday 16 December 2005 would be much appreciated.
