Disabled toilet – No soap or hand dryer; condition unacceptable – needed cleaning; unclear where the emergency alarm goes to and in the wrong place; no indication where to get a radar key (possibly at town council and community office during working hours?).

Ladies toilet – No toilet roll handler.

## St Bees Foreshore – Visited 15/05/07 11.45am

No signage showing times of opening. No indication of cleaning schedules.

Ladies toilet – No soap or plug

Mother and Baby Room – No soap or plug

No bins for nappies

Paint colour not very friendly could do with a more

appropriate colour

Disabled toilet - Disabled handle needs replacing

No alarm No mirror

Door stiff and difficult to open

Needs cleaning No light switch

Men's toilet - No soap but bins

Dogs toilet - Needs gate at entrance

Needs disabled spaces in front of the toilet that allows for wheelchair access

Wishing well needs removing or completely renovating as currently an eyesore

Large yellow Public notice before the promenade that states "use of the promenade is at your own risk" should be rewritten to be more inviting to new visitors

# <u>James Street, Whitehaven – Visited 15/05/07 12.15pm</u>

No signage showing times of opening. Cleaning schedules finished in June 2006.

Ladies and Disabled toilets in need of cleaning Disabled toilet – can't pull chain

Rubbish bins left outside.

No staff available – needed during more busy times.
