Please make your members aware that this is a very high quality, 2 day residential programme. We will be booking accommodation for Monday 27th October for all members booked. Obviously once your members are booked on, we would urge them not to cancel their place unless obviously there are unforeseen urgent circumstances which mean they cannot attend.

There will be up to 25 places for members across all 7 Authorities. However, due to Eden moving to the Leader/Cabinet Model of Governance, we will reserve 5 spaces for Eden O & S members. Every other Authority can fill between 3 - 4 places up to the maximum number of 25.

Next Steps

The Programme is being funded by ACE and is a fantastic opportunity for all Chairs, Vice Chairs and aspiring Chairs to develop their own skills and also to develop together as a cross Authority group of O & S Chairs and Vice Chairs. The joint working in particular is seen as a real positive of the programme.
