1.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION

1.1 Full planning permission for the above proposed development was refused on 11 January 2006 for the following reason:-

“By virtue of its size, design and siting, the proposed extension would have an adverse dominant affect on the neighbouring property to the rear, particularly in terms of loss of daylighting, contrary to Policy HSG 20 of the Copeland Local Plan 2001-2016 2nd Deposit Version”.

1.2.1 A subsequent appeal to the Planning Inspectorate has been ALLOWED. A copy of the Inspector's decision letter is appended to this report.
