Recommendation – that the Committee considers how the Council should respond to the NHS public consultation on the "Closer to Home" proposals.

BACKGROUND

The NHS is currently carrying out a public consultation across North Cumbria regarding the future of health services and the future role of its hospitals.

These proposals entitled "Closer to Home" are part of a strategy to provide more health services closer to people's homes and a copy of the consultation on the proposals is attached.

The public consultation is due to end on 1 February 2008 and the Committee is invited to recommend the council's response to this consultation to be considered by full council at its meeting on 22nd January 2008.

It is proposed that the meeting draw up the recommendations following a number of witness sessions to look at all the issues involved. A draft running order is appended (Final confirmation is still awaited from a number of witnesses) and a set of preliminary questions that have been sent to the potential witnesses. The A & E session is likely to be a presentation rather than questions as it is a late addition to the timetable.

Also appended is the response of the "Save Our Services" Group to these proposals.
