1.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1.1 The County Council, as the statutory footpaths authority, is seeking the views of this Council on the proposed diversion of a section of Footpath No. 431021, as illustrated on the attached plan.
- 1.2 The existing route, from point D on the roadside runs in a generally north westerly direction along a track and then trodden path before turning west-south-westerly through a field gate into a pasture field. There running up the hill west-south-westerly and turning at right angles to run south and then south west to point C, a distance of approximately 500 metres.
- 1.3 The proposed route would run from point A on the roadside in a generally west-south-westerly direction beside the field boundary over a grass surface for a distance of approximately 280 metres to point B where it would turn to continue following the field boundary and run in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 60 metres to point C to rejoin the route to remain.
- 1.4 The reason for the proposed diversion, as is permitted under the Highways Act 1980, is that the diversion is for the benefit of the applicant.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Council do not raise any objections to the proposed diversion which offers a slightly shorter route for this section of footpath.
