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Overview and Scrutiny – Schools in the West

Enjoying and achieving West Area

Primary Data – the percentage of primary schools at MS 1 level of support has been sustained, although not necessarily the same schools. Of the 22 changes of levels in primary schools from September 2004 to April 2005 schools, 13 schools now receive a greater level of support and 9 less. Where schools are receiving a greater level of support, 2 are concerned with leadership and management, including supporting new and acting heads and 10 are concerned with standards either falling or not rising rapidly enough. All of these schools receive support through the Primary Strategy and/or associate headteachers. Where schools are receiving less support, 4 have been concerned with improved leadership and management, leading to better standards and 5 are related to much improved standards.

Secondary Data -

The percentage of secondary schools at MS 1 level of support has been sustained. Of the changes of levels in secondary schools from September 2004 to April 2005 schools, 2 schools now receive a greater level of support and 3 less. Where schools are receiving a greater level of support, 1 was identified as causing concern as a result of an LEA review and the other was identified as having serious weaknesses by OFSTED both are concerned with raising standards of attainment and in improving aspects of leadership and management. Where schools have improved, good leadership and management are having a positive impact on standards at both key stages.

To address the issues in individual schools and groups of schools with similar profiles. Where schools are in levels T1, M1 or M2, the support of behavior professionals is built into Improvement plans and is the impact is monitored through SSMG (School Specific Monitoring group).

KS 3 to age 15 value Added
LEA average: 98.6%

3 schools fell below the LEA average, 5 schools were at or are near the LEA average and 7 schools exceed the LEA average. All three schools that fell below the average are receiving intervention packages from the LEA at either T2 or M1 2.

KS2 to age 11 value added
LEA average: 983.7

6 schools fell below the LEA average, 1 school was near to LEA average and 7 schools were higher than the LEA average. Of the 6 schools that fell below the average, 4 are receiving monitoring and intervention packages and 2 receive targeted packages of support from the Secondary Strategy.
