## 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Council on the 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2005 appointed a Licensing Committee comprising of 12 members and 4 Licensing Sub-Committees each having three members with their memberships fixed. Consideration has previously been given, by Officers and the Chairman of the Licensing Sub-Committees to membership being changed to a rota basis. This will make it significantly easier to appoint a Sub-committee as and when necessary. Under the present system, if any member of a particular sub-committee is unavailable or is barred from considering an application the whole Sub-Committee cannot sit. Whilst it is unlikely that all four Sub-Committees are unavailable it would be much easier if membership of a sub-committee could be taken from a list of 12 members in rota order (to ensure each member has an opportunity) and according to availability on a particular date. It is expected that Licensing Sub-Committees will have to meet at short notice and that members may already have other commitments in their diaries.

- 1.2 It is recommended that the membership of the Sub-Committees be taken from the Membership of the Licensing Committee on a rota basis and subject to availability.
- 1.3 The Licensing Committee would comprise of the following members:-

P Connolly (Chairman) (Sub-Committee Chairman); S Meteer (Deputy Chairman) (Sub-Committee Chairman); J Hewitson (Sub-Committee Chairman); Mrs. J K Johnston (Sub-Committee Chairman);

N Clarkson, R S Cole, Mrs. M D Docherty, J Prince, R Salkeld, G Sunderland, P Tyson, A Wonnacott

By way of example the first Sub-Committee would comprise of Councillors Connolly, Cole and Docherty: assuming those three members attended that Sub-Committee meeting, the next Sub-Committee would comprise of Councillor S. Meteer, J. Prince and R. Salkeld. If Councillor Prince was not available then Councillor Sunderland would be asked to attend and so on. A further advantage of this system is that if at the last minute a member cannot attend then a replacement member can immediately be drawn on to attend.
