1. Introduction

1.1 The developer has suggested **Jefferson Park** as the street name for consideration.

- 1.2 The developer stated in his letter of request that the name had been selected because of it's historical connection with the Jefferson Family and Whitehaven. Also they felt it would be appropriate for the site.
- 1.3 It is envisaged that this road name will apply to the 'entrance' road running through the site. Any cul-de-sacs or other roads are expected to have other names applied to them in due course.
