Summary	To carry out a review of Polling Districts and Polling Places as set out in Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006.

1 INTRODUCTION

The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 introduced a change to the timing of compulsory reviews of UK Parliamentary polling districts and polling places. The next compulsory review must now be started and completed between 1 October 2013 and 31 January 2015 (inclusive).

Any changes resulting from this review will be published in the revised register on 1 December 2014.

Subsequent reviews must be started and completed within the period of 16 months that starts on 1 October of every fifth year after 1 October 2013.

A polling district is a geographical area created by the sub-division of a constituency, ward or division into smaller parts. A polling place is the building or area in which polling stations will be selected by the Returning Officer. A polling station is the room or area within the polling place where voting takes place.

2 PROPOSALS

- 2.1 We are looking for feedback on any aspect of polling districts and/or polling places currently used and invite representation and comments from interested persons.
- 2.2 Local political parties and Councillors will be consulted and views are invited from electors within the Parliamentary Constituency of Copeland as well as such persons as may have particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.
- 2.3 The consultation period for the review will commence on **Monday 23rd June** and end on **Friday 1st August 2014**.

- 2.4 Explanatory Guide is shown at Appendix 1
- 2.5 Current Polling district details are shown at Appendix 2.
- 2.6 (Acting) Returning Officer's comments and proposals are shown at Appendix 3.
- 2.7 A maximum of four meetings between now and 1st November is expected to be necessary to complete this review. More will be arranged if necessary.

3 CONCLUSION

- 3.1 The Working Party is asked to:
 - (i) Consider any initial views on Polling Districts and Polling Places
 - (ii) Review any recommendations received during the consultation period
 - (iii) Finalise the review in time for any alterations to be included in the new register to be published on 1st December 2014.

Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations 2014

Introduction

Under the Representation of the People Act 1983, local authorities are required to divide their area into polling districts, to designate polling places for those polling districts, and to keep their electoral arrangements under review.

The Electoral Registration Act 2006 introduces a duty for all polling districts and polling places to be reviewed every four years. The Council's last review was carried out in 2011.

The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 amended this duty to require the next statutory review to take place in the period of 16 months from 1 October 2013. Copeland Borough Council will commence this review in June 2014.

Any changes resulting from this review will be published in the revised register on 1 December 2014.

Each polling district must offer reasonable facilities for voting for all its electors, as far as it is practicable in the circumstances.

Polling Districts

A polling district is a geographical area created by the sub-division of a UK Parliamentary constituency for the purposes of a UK Parliamentary election.

In England, each parish is to be a separate polling district and, in Wales, each community should be a separate polling district, unless there are special circumstances.

Polling Place

A polling place is the building or area in which polling stations will be selected by the (Acting) Returning Officer. A polling place within a polling district must be designated so that polling stations are within easy reach of all electors from across the polling district.

Polling Station

A polling station is the room or area within the polling place where voting takes place. Unlike polling districts and polling places which are fixed by the local authority, polling stations are chosen by the relevant Returning Officer for the election.

Aim of the review

In conducting the review, the council must seek to ensure that:-

- All electors in the constituency have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances;
- Polling places are accessible to all electors and all sections of the community; and

- When considering or reviewing the designation of a polling place, have regard to accessibility needs of disabled persons.

What is being reviewed?

- The polling district Boundaries within each ward of the District
- The location of the polling station in each district
- The access to each polling station
- Buildings that might be considered for use as polling stations

What cannot be review at this time?

- The ward boundaries
- The parish Boundaries
- The parliamentary constituency boundaries

- Resident of Copeland Borough
- Local councillors
- The Members of Parliament for the Copeland Constituency
- Political Parties
- Town & Parish Councils
- The Acting Returning Officer
- Voluntary Groups
- Community Groups

Polling Districts & Polling Places Review

Background

Within each local authority area, legislation requires councils to carry out reviews of the Polling Districts and Polling Places in that area. The recent Electoral Registration & Administration Act 2013 changed the timing of these reviews and the next review must be held between 1 October 2013 and 31 January 2015 with subsequent reviews held within a 16 month period starting on 1 October every fifth year after 1 October 2013.

This Council's last review was held in 2011 which resulted in no changes being made.

A council's area is divided into polling districts, with one or more polling districts making up a district ward, with a polling place being an area or building within a polling district in which a polling station is situated. Consequently, it is inevitable that polling stations are also considered as part of these reviews.

These reviews are based on council areas or parliamentary constituencies and, consequently, it is imperative that the views of the (Acting) Returning Officer are sought and considered.

The Review in Copeland

Polling districts, polling places and polling stations will be considered and this Review will take into account the following:-

- The position and size of the polling place and whether it is appropriate for the polling district and provides sufficient flexibility;
- The availability of postal votes on demand; and
- The suitability of a polling station with regard to:-
 - Accessibility and effectiveness for the majority of the voters in the polling district;
 - Facilities for voters and, in particular, for those with a disability; and
 - Whether the premises provide economic efficiency with regard to the number of personal voters allocated at a polling station, in particular if they have less than 100 electors voting in person.

As well as this, the current polling district lettering/numbering sequences no longer follow any logical sequence, therefore it is proposed that all polling districts are renumbered as part of this review. The most logical way to do this would be: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2 etc based on wards.
