The Cumbria County Council, in association with most other Cumbrian local planning authorities has proposed a draft SPD on Wind Energy. The document is designed to help planning authorities deal with this type of development particularly in relation to recent government and regional policy requirements. It is intended to consult widely on the document as a joint authority exercise and to report back with any proposed changes to Full Council for adoption.
