1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 At the request of a parish council, a district council may under section 75 of Local Government Act 1972 change the name of a parish in its area. No consultation is required

- 1.2 The act requires the district council upon agreeing a change of name to:
 - (a) send a notice of any change made to the Secretary of State, to the Director General of the Ordnance Survey and to the Registrar General; and
 - (b) Publish notice of changes in the parish and elsewhere in such manner as they consider appropriate.

2 PROPOSALS

- 2.1 Beckermet Parish Council has requested that the name of the new Beckermet Parish Council created in 2011 following a community governance review be changed to incorporate Thornhill.
- 2.2 The proposed name is Beckermet with Thornhill Parish Council.

3 CONCLUSION

3.1 Agreement to the change of a name of a parish falls outside of the terms of reference of the Working Party, and Council is therefore asked to consider and approve the proposed change of parish name.
