### MDP 21/11 Personal Development Plans (PDPs)

The Panel were provided with an earlier version of the PDP template than that included with the Agenda. After a discussion, members stated a preference for the version that was originally sent as part of the Agenda item.

Members were advised by the Democratic Services Manager that the timescale originally indicated by Ms S Dunworth stating that the PDP process would be completed by the end of July 2011 was not practicable and that August would be a more realistic target.

The Panel were also of the opinion that it was better to have a realistic target date and not to rush the process. Members expressed a view that newly elected Members should be given priority in booking PDP interviews.

It was also suggested that the Group Leaders together with the Chair and Vice Chair of this Panel contact the Members in order to book PDP appointments.
