# Dates for your diary

The **Radioactive Waste Planning Group** will meet on 10 March at University of London, Malet Street, London, 12.30 to 3.30. Items on the agenda include a round up of local and national developments and a preliminary review of the consultation on plutonium management.

On March 22, 2011 NuLeAF is holding a **seminar** on **Spatial Planning and the implementation of strategy for managing nuclear industry Low Level Waste (LLW)**. Speakers include DECC, Low Level Waste Repository Ltd, and Cumbria, Suffolk and Northamptonshire County Councils. The venue will be Local Government House and the seminar will run from 11.00 to 3.30. The next **Steering Group** meeting will be held in Manchester Town Hall on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 11.00 to 3.00. DECC has been invited to give the afternoon presentation/discussion, which is likely to provide an overview of its work on radioactive waste management and opportunities to discuss any aspects thereof.

#### NDA News

- NDA has published the latest issue of <u>Insight</u>, rounding up the latest news at its sites. Articles include: graphite options under scrutiny; change of approach to cut timeframes; construction of waste plant to begin; and historic milestone as reactors close.
- It has also published a series of scientific and technical reports explaining how it will go about developing the safety case for a Geological Disposal Facility (<u>Generic Disposal System Safety</u> <u>Case</u>).

#### **SLC News**

- Magnox North and Magnox South have combined forces to operate as Magnox Limited.
- Regulators have granted approval for Oldbury to <u>continue operating Reactor 2</u> until 30 June 2011, which brings it in line with Reactor 1.
- The decommissioned reactors at Berkeley are the first to be put in to <u>SafeStore</u>.

### West Cumbria MRWS Partnership

The latest <u>meeting report</u> and <u>e-bulletin</u> have been published on the Partnership website, and the Partnership has <u>extended it's thanks</u> to the people of West Cumbria for participating in discussions on the possibility of siting the Geological Disposal Facility.
