## To consider the creation of the above Tree Preservation Order

**Recommendation:** That Tree Preservation Order No. 1 : 2006 is created.

## 1.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1.1 In 2004 a survey was carried out with all local Town and Parish Councils asking for areas to be put forward which warranted surveying under the criteria laid down in the Landscape/Tree Appraisal. The outcome of these evaluations would hopefully identify whether there are areas within Copeland which should be considered for tree protection under a Tree Preservation Order.
- 1.2 One of the areas highlighted by Egremont Town Council was the garden of No. 2 Park View, Egremont which contains a medium mature Common Oak (Quercus Robur).
- 1.3 A landscape appraisal was carried out on 15 July 2005 by the Council's Landscape Technical Officer to evaluate the need for any appropriate protection, a copy of which is attached to this report. The officer recommended that the tree is put forward for protection by way of a Tree Preservation Order as it is a very good specimen. For this reason it is recommended that Order is created.
