PP48/14 Minutes

PP49/14 Declarations of Interest

Councillor Joan Hully declared a non-pecuniary interest in Planning Application 4/14/2375/0F1 – Application for the erection of One Wind Turbine (Maximum Hub Height of 30.52m and a Maximum tip height of 48.01m) with Control Box and all associated works at Land near Cobra Castle, Egremont due to being a Cleator Moor Town Councillor.

The considered permitted use of the building is considered to be within use Classes D1/D2 at The Civic Hall, Lowther Street, Whitehaven.
