STREET NAMING AND NUMBERING NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT – FORMER MARCHON CAR PARK, HIGH ROAD, WHITEHAVEN

To ask members to decide on the street names for the proposed new housing development, known as Magellan Park, Whitehaven

Recommendation:

That the street names Hartfield Close, Ladstock Grove, Leander Close and Woodville Way be adopted for the housing development and all the relevant bodies be notified.

Resources Implications: Cost of providing street nameplates if the request is approved.

1.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1.1. The site is a development located on the former Marchon Car Park, High Road, Whitehaven.
- 1.2. The developer has suggested Hartfield Close, Ladstock Grove, Leander Close and Woodville Way for the development. These names are connected with Sailing Ships that were built in Whitehaven.
- 1.3. The developer has suggested that the houses which face onto High Road be re-named. The current numbering system on High Road would allow for these to be incorporated as numbers 183 213 (odds only), however, there would be a significant distance between the existing 181 High Road (located on Kells) and this development as 1-42 Snaefell Terrace runs between them. This could lead to confusion for delivery and emergency services in locating this section of High Road.
