**Recommendation: That the proposal be supported**

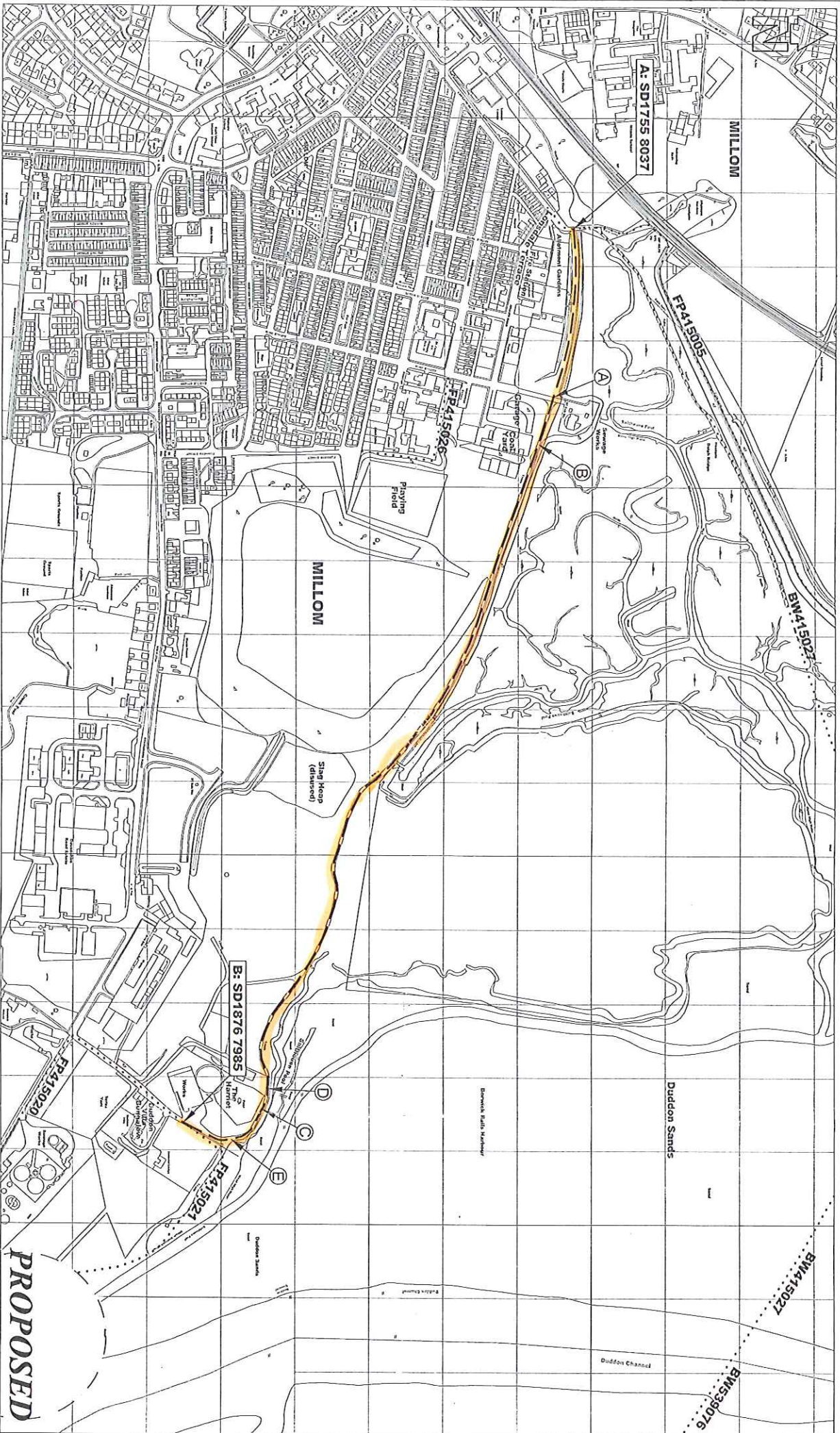

**1.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION**

- 1.1 The Council has been consulted as land owner by Cumbria County Council, in respect of an application under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 for a Modification Order to be made to add a section of public footpath to the Council's Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way situate on the site of the former Ironworks in Millom.
- 1.2 The application is based on the evidence of uninterrupted use by local people on foot from as far back as 1968 to the present day.
- 1.3 In the light of this evidence the proposal is considered worthy of support.
