## **Cumbria Choice Lettings Outcomes 2011/12**

### Summary and Recommendation:

Attached as Appendix A is a lettings and applications analysis of Cumbria Choice from the day it went live in May 2011 to 31 March 2012. This is for information and members' comments.

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 A virtually full year report has become available for the first time since the scheme was introduced. This is the first of a series of such reports.

### 2. Appendix A

- 2.1 Page 1 shows that 51 lettings were made to statutorily homeless customers in Copeland out of 354 total allocations in the Borough. 14.41% of Copeland Allocations were therefore made to homeless households. This compares to 12.23% across Cumbria.
- 2.2 The first table on page 2 shows the number and percentage of homelessness lettings compared to all allocations by named provider organisations in the county.
- 2.3 Pages 2 and 3 show a quarterly summary of all lettings made in each District by Cumbria Choice Bands A, B, C, D, D+ and E with Band A being the highest priority. On the lower half of page 3 there is both a summary and percentage analysis of this information from May 2011 to 31 March 2012, almost a full year. It shows that almost half of all allocations in Copeland were made to customers in Band C. Just over one fifth were made to Band A.
- 2.5 The relatively small number of allocations made to the highest band is explained on page 4, which contains the number and percentage of applicants registered on Cumbria Choice by Band in each of the six District Councils on 18 April 2012. This shows only 64 out of 2059 applications registered for Copeland being in Band A. Band C had 626 applications registered.
- 2.6 Members will see that more allocations were made to Band C than any other band because this Band contains the highest number of applicants. Band A still has the

highest priority, as evidenced by 72 lettings in 2011/12 which accounted for most of the customers who were placed in that Band during the year.

### 3 NEXT STEPS

- 3.1 The review of Cumbria Choice policy began in February 2012 at the Cumbria Choice Project Board and also with a special meeting of the Strategic Housing Panel on 3 February (to which all Councillors were invited).
- 3.2 The Project Board's review is likely to complete in July 2012 with a subsequent report to the Strategic Housing Panel for its meeting in August. It is expected to provide a renewed policy umbrella beneath which we will be able to adopt local lettings policies for areas in the Borough where supply and demand plus community support require.
- 3.3 We can therefore expect to give further consideration to local lettings policies after the shape of the overall policy umbrella is known. This is a key policy decision for the Council and cannot be adopted without explicit approval of elected members.
