**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE/
CLUB PREMISES CERTIFICATE**

Premises	<i>Quay Street Sount & Quay Street North Quay Street Whitehaven CA28 7DN</i>
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Notice is given that *Whitehaven Harbour Commissioners* has applied to Cumberland Council Licensing Authority to vary the Premises Licence or Club Premises Certificate under the Licensing Act 2003.

The proposed variation is:
<i>Extend the licence from 4 to 12 days per calendar year for all licensable activities, 6 of these allowing for the sale of alcohol.</i>
<i>The performance of plays, dance, films, live music and recorded music between the hours of 0900 – 2300 on any day of the week.</i>
<i>The supply of alcohol Thursday 1500 -2300, Friday 1000 – 2300, Saturday 1000 – 2300 and Sunday 1000 – 2300.</i>
<i>Late night refreshments Thursday – Sunday 2300 -0000.</i>
<i>Additional 270m approx. of land to the side of the area between Bardywell Heights and the wall of the Argos Carpark to be added to the total area of the licence.</i>
