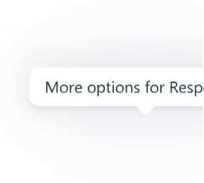

The proposal failed to consult with local residents. I live less than quarter of a mile from the Sneckyeat site and only found out about the proposed traveller site today (13/07/22) via social media. As a local resident I would have expected the council to at least leaflet dropped or post returnable consultation forms to locals regarding the proposed site. In addition, given the structures are not permanent the doesn't appear to have been any consideration given to the fact that the site is exposed on top of a hill to the elements from all angles (wind being the obvious concern). Traveller sites are typically located on more naturally protected areas. A row of trees around the boundary will not suffice, in fact it may cause more of a risk to the residents in adverse weather. I cannot locate any community impact assessments in relation to consideration to the fact the the local area already has some of the highest rates of antisocial behaviour in Copeland. There is no such mention of the elephant in the room that is the political leaning of locals in the area, historical voting suggests that Hensingham has an unacceptably high level of far right wing views. Perhaps in the interest of traveller safety, some consideration should be given to the disproportionately high amount of extreme views of some locals. You cannot design out crime from a community, especially by placing a traveller site within a community where local views, by far right wing political affiliations are likely to be exacerbated. There's is an evident lack of suitable infrastructure, particularly the proposed site entrance, without such, I cannot see how non-permanent structure will access the site without disrupting the road network, particularly for local farmers and resident who use the access Galemire via Sneckyeat Road. Without prior infrastructure investment i cant see how it would be possible for planning permissions to be granted. The fact that there is a water main running through the proposed Sneckyeat site should have eliminated it from consideration, given that United Utilities do not allow building over, or in close proximity to a water main. The consultation document for the Sneckyeat site clearly shows more objections than support. Concerns around habit destruction, light and noise pollution are sparsely cited. Moreover the site is on a former tip. If previous planning permission fir allotments has been refused who is it that the site is suitable for travellers to live? Further information re the above should be provided, and only then can a legitimate consultation take place, people cannot support the proposal on the limited information provided and without further exploration of the concerns raised. I understand there is a need for a traveller site, but the site shouldn't just be allocated to Sneckyeat because its the best of a bad bunch of cherrypicked sites. The council should endeavour to find a site that is suitable for travellers and the community in which it is located, Sneckyeat evidently is not suitable.

Community impact assessments, for the current situation and those specific to the risks the traveller community could face in light of the comments made in comment 11 regarding ASB and far right views of a disproportionately high number of local residents. An assessment on the impacts of non permanent structures being places in such and exposed (to the elements) area. The lack of support evidenced in the consultation for the Sneckyeat site should rule it out as a suitable site. The consultation document for the Sneckyeat site clearly shows more objections than support. Concerns around habit destruction, light and noise pollution are sparsely cited. Moreover the site is on a former tip. If previous planning permission for allotments has been refused who is it that the site is suitable for travellers to live? Further information re the above should be provided, and only then can a legitimate consultation take place, people cannot support the proposal on the limited information provided and without further exploration of the concerns raised. Perhaps once the council answers these questions consideration should be given to a further public consultation. Sneckyeat should not be chosen as a suitable site due to the Councils inability and lack of will to locate a suitable site for the traveller community.

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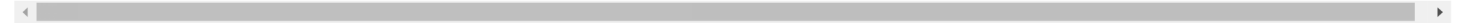

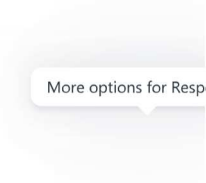
