Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places 2019

Report of (Acting) Returning Officer for Copeland Borough Council – Final

January 2020

Introduction

The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013, requires all Local Authorities to undertake a compulsory review of polling district and polling places every five years.

The Act requires that the local authority consults widely before reaching a decision on its preferred electoral arrangements. In addition, the Acting Returning Officer for each constituency is required to submit his or her own proposals for future electoral arrangements. What follows are the proposals for Copeland Borough Council.

Background

Since October 2013, all local authorities have been required to review their polling districts, polling places, and polling stations every five years.

The next compulsory review period is from October 2018 to Jan 2020 and Copeland Borough Council have now commenced its review.

This Council's last review was held in 2014 which resulted in a few minor changes being made.

In 2018 The Local Government Boundary Commission for England (LGBCE) completed an electoral review of the Copeland District. Details of the consultation process and final recommendations can be found here at: http://www.lgbce.org.uk/all-reviews/north-west/cumbria/copeland

Following the LGBCE review, the number of district wards was reduced from 25 to 17 and the number of district Councillors was reduced from 51 to 33.

The Review in Copeland

Copeland is divided into 100 polling districts, with one or more polling districts making up a district ward, with a polling place being an area or building within a polling district in which a polling station is situated. Consequently, it is inevitable that polling stations are also considered as part of these reviews.

These reviews are based on council areas or parliamentary constituencies and, consequently, it is imperative that the views of the (Acting) Returning Officer are sought and considered.

Polling districts, polling places and polling stations will be considered and this Review will take into account the following:-

- The position and size of the polling place and whether it is appropriate for the polling district and provides sufficient flexibility;
- The availability of postal votes on demand; and
- The suitability of a polling station with regard to:-
 - Accessibility and effectiveness for the majority of the voters in the polling district;
 - o Facilities for voters and, in particular, for those with a disability; and
 - Whether the premises provide economic efficiency with regard to the number of personal voters allocated at a polling station, in particular if they have less than 100 electors voting in person.

- BCS-4 electors to be moved to Waberthwaite Polling Station. An investigation by Copeland Disability Forum has resulted in moving electors from BCS-4 to Waberthwaite Village Hall. Corney Parish Hall has been deemed an unsuitable venue. However, they have informed us that they will be conducting renovations on the hall and will to keep us up to date on renovations which, once completed, will be reviewed.
- Polling districts BCS-5 and BCS-13 to be merged. This will result in those electors currently in BCS-5 changing stations to vote at St Bega's Eskdale Village Hall, which is closer for them, rather than Muncaster Parish Hall. Renumber to BCS-5
- Polling districts BCS-11 and BCS-12 to be merged and renumbered to BCS-11. All electors will then vote at Silecroft Village Hall due to its central location and respectable distance for electors to travel. Kirsanton Village Hall will no longer be required. This view is supported by Whicham Parish Council.

- Proposal to tidy up polling district boundaries on H-2, H-3, H-4 and H-5 within the Hillcrest Ward. Maps available setting out new boundaries. Proposals will result in a change of polling station for approximately 30 electors.
- Current H-2 will be split along Moresby Road and join with the current H-3. This will mean that electors on Cleator Moor Road, High Stile Gardens and New Monkwray Farm will be moved from Red Lonning Community Centre Booth 2 to Richmond Pensioners Social Club for their polling station. Officers recommend that this new polling district be renumbered to H-4.
- The polling district boundary that works along Jubilee Road and up Red Lonning is proposed to move so that it will continue up Caldbeck Road. This will mean that electors on Caldbeck Road, Chatsworth Drive, Sandhurst Drive, Sandringham Avenue and Winchester Avenue previously in H-5 will join the updated H-2. There will be no change in polling station. Officers recommend that this new polling district be renumbered to H-3.
- The remaining properties on H-5, those not merged to become the new H-3, will be merged with the current H-4. This will result in a slight change in polling station, moving from Booth 2 of Red Lonning Community Centre to Booth 1 for those from H-5. Officers recommend that this new polling district be renumbered to H-2.
