NOTICE OF MINOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE/CLUB
PREMISES CERTIFICATE

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| Premises | SPAR Store, Park Garage, Springfield Road Bigrigg, Egremont, CA22 2TL |
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Notice is given that James Hall & Company Ltd has applied to Copeland Borough Council Licensing Authority for minor variation of a Premises Licence or Club Premises Certificate under the Licensing Act 2003.

The proposed minor variation is: To update the conditions

1. All staff whose responsibilities include the retail sale of alcohol shall receive training on induction and thereafter annually on:
 - a) The terms, conditions and restrictions of the premises licence:
 - b) The prevention of unlawful sales of alcohol, the operation of the "Challenge 25" scheme, types of acceptable ID, refusing sales of alcohol to persons who may be drunk and any other relevant matters.

2. Such training shall be recorded, and these records shall be kept on the premises and shall, on request, be made available on request to the Police and / or an Authorised Officer of the Licensing Authority
(as defined by Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003):
 - a) In the case of on-line training: within 48 hours.
 - b) In all other cases: immediately upon request.
