Notice is given that in accordance with Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) and the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, this Adoption Statement hereby gives notice that on the 7th September 2021, Copeland Borough Council adopted the Shopfront Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) which comes into effect on the 7th September 2021.

Any such application should be made promptly and in any event no later than three months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted
