Trees on privately owned land and Tree Preservation Orders (TPO)



Special planning controls that protect trees, and what you need to do if you intend to fell, prune or do work to them.

Many trees that are important to the local environment are subject to Tree Preservation Orders. This means that you need to apply to the Council for permission to fell, prune or do other work to them.

It is an offence to do work to a tree covered by a Tree Preservation Order without first getting permission from us.
