#### Introduction

#### **Purpose of the Survey**

The Copeland Local Plan provides the framework for sustainable development in the borough. A key part of this is to ensure that development takes place in locations which provide the best access to essential local services and employment opportunities. These 'Local Centres' might be a single large village or a group of villages. New development should be focused in or near the borough's towns or to these centres.

This survey establishes the level of services and employment opportunities available in each of the borough's settlements outside the 4 main towns and will therefore inform the settlement hierarchy and development strategy for the Copeland Local Plan.

The report itself is merely a statement of fact and does not draw any conclusions as to which villages or groups of villages should be designated as Local Centres. This work will be carried out as part of the preparation of the Local Plan itself.

All settlement boundaries where shown on the plans are as per the Copeland Local Plan 2001-2016 (adopted in 2006).

This Survey builds on the initial Village Services Survey from 2010 and can also help to identify the change that has taken place since 2010.

#### Methodology

All of the settlements included in the study were visited during April 2017 and details of the number, type and location of all services (where present) were noted on a standard form. This included services outside the adopted settlement boundaries where they related to an existing Local Centre. The information was them circulated to Parish Councils in July 2017 to ensure that all services had been properly recorded. The document was then updated to reflect this feedback.

This information has been collated in the following way:

- A table summarising the level of services in each settlement
- Number of services in 2017 and 2010 and differences
- The location of each facility has been plotted using GIS software onto OS mapping and the maps and supporting tables for each village can be found in the Appendix

St Bees have also lost 2 services with St Bees School closing but is scheduled to reopen in 2018, Platform 9 restaurant changing use to a BnB.








