


FRONT ELEVATION

## **FEATURES**

- \* Flat profile roof tiles.
- \* Dry verge detail.
- \* UPVC fascia at eaves, with brick corbel to gable in same brick as main elevation
- \* Brick soldier course heads.
- \* Plain side hung casement windows.
- \* Brick soldier course cills.
- \* Half glazed main entrance door, with lean to canopy over on "gallows brackets"
- \* Dark brick below DPC

## **CONCRETE BRICKS**

- Where concrete bricks are used in lieu of standard clay bricks, bed joint reinforcement must be installed in the outer leaf, two courses above and below any opening, extending 600mm beyond either side of the opening.
- Refer to GF working plan for details of any additional movement joints required.
