Thank you for consulting me on the amended/further information submitted for the above application.

I understand that the archaeological excavation of the area surrounding the prehistoric pits that were earlier discovered on the site has been completed. However, I can see no report on the results of the excavation submitted as part of the additional information. I therefore recommend that, in order to secure the submission of an acceptable report on the archaeological excavation, comments I made to you in a letter dated 01 November 2021 are still considered appropriate. I recommend that the submission of the archaeological report be secured through the inclusion of a condition in any planning consent. I suggest the following form of words:

No development shall commence within the site until the applicant has secured the implementation of a programme of archaeological work in accordance with a written scheme of investigation which has been submitted by the applicant and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

Reason: To afford reasonable opportunity for an examination to be made to determine the existence of any remains of archaeological interest within the site and for the examination and recording of such remains.
