1	Sycamore	Remove epicormics shoots
3	Horse Chestnut	Crown lift away from building and thin
4	Beech	Crown lift away from house and path side to balance
6	Alder x 2	Sever ivy. Crown lift both and reduce right hand tree back
		from lighting, footpath and building
7	Beech	Sever ivy
8	Cherry	Sever ivy
15	Cherry	Remove adjacent elderberry

For your information a copy of the Council's Consultant Arboriculturalist's report is enclosed.

Please note whilst the removal of ivy does not require notice be served on the Council, you should take every care to avoid damaging the trees whilst undertaking the ivy removal works.

Your Right of Appeal

If you disagree with our decision you can appeal to The Planning Inspectorate, Environment and Transport Team, 3/A Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol, BS1 6PN within 28 days from the date you received this decision.

Compensation

If you wish to make a claim you must do so within 12 months from the date of this decision (or, if you appeal to the Secretary of State, within 12 months from the date of this decision).
