 The felled tree T1 is to be replaced during the first available planting season following the felling operation by three 6-8cm girth light standard field maples as close to the location of the tree they replace, or such other size, species, location or period as may be agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority. If a replacement tree dies, becomes diseased or is damaged within 5 years of the date it is planted it must be replaced in the next

available planting season by others of a similar size and species.

Reason

To ensure the continuity of amenity in accordance with 'Policy DM28 – Protection of Trees' of the Copeland Local Plan 2013-2028.

2. The felled tree T3 is to be replaced during the first available planting season following the felling operation by three 6-8cm girth light standard sessile oaks as close to the location of the tree they replace, or such other size, species, location or period as may be agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority. If a replacement tree dies, becomes diseased or is damaged within 5 years of the date it is planted it must be replaced in the next available planting season by others of a similar size and species.

Reason

To ensure the continuity of amenity in accordance with 'Policy DM28 – Protection of Trees' of the Copeland Local Plan 2013-2028.

3. The crown lifting shall be undertaken in accordance with section 7.6 Crown lifting BS3998:2010 Tree work – Recommendations.

Reason

In accordance with Section 198 of the 1990 Town and Country Planning Act and in the interest of good forestry and arboricultural practice.

For your information a copy of the Council's Consultant Arboriculturalist's report is enclosed.

Your Right of Appeal

If you disagree with our decision you can appeal to The Planning Inspectorate, Environment and Transport Team, 3/A Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol, BS1 6PN within 28 days from the date you received this decision.

Compensation

If you suffer any loss or damage as a result of a condition attached to this consent, you might be entitled to recover compensation from the Council. If you wish to make a claim you must do so within 12 months from the date of this decision (or, if you appeal to the Secretary of State, within 12 months from the date of this decision). Claims should be made in writing to the Development
