Stairwell

Alteration of proposed external finish of the stairwell from a rainscreen cladding finish to a concrete panel finish.

Increasing the height of the stairwell and amending roof from mono-pitch to flat roof. Revision of window composition. Addition of window.

Service/Infrastructure Areas Reconfiguration of and addition of vents.

Elevations Introduction of panels surrounding/adjacent to fenestration. Revision of window and door composition.
