Tree Replacement

The felled trees must be replaced during the first available planting season following the felling operation at the same location as the trees they replace by one 1-2ft tall scots pine in a 2L pot and two light standard small leaf limes, or such other size, species, location or period as may be agreed in



writing by the Local Planning Authority. If a replacement tree dies, becomes diseased or is damaged within 5 years of the date it is planted then it must be replaced in the next available planting season by another of a similar size and species.

Reason

To ensure the continuity of amenity in accordance with 'Policy DM28 – Protection of Trees' of the Copeland Local Plan 2013-2028.

Tree Pruning General

The pruning shall comply with current best practice as detailed in Section 7.6 Crown lifting and 7.7 Crown reduction and reshaping BS 3998:2021 Tree work – Recommendations.

Reason

To ensure the continuity of amenity in accordance with 'Policy DM28 – Protection of Trees' of the Copeland Local Plan 2013-2028.

Extent of pruning

The pruning of the lateral branches of the trees along the roadside numbered T5 on the plan shall not exceed a reduction of more than 3m beyond the edge of the road to a height above the existing ground level not exceeding 6m.

Reason

To ensure the continuity of amenity in accordance with 'Policy DM28 – Protection of Trees' of the Copeland Local Plan 2013-2028.

For your information a copy of the Council's Consultant Arboriculturalist's report is enclosed.

Your Right of Appeal

If you disagree with our decision you can appeal to The Planning Inspectorate, Environment and Transport Team, 3/A Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol, BS1 6PN within 28 days from the date you received this decision.

Compensation

If you suffer any loss or damage as a result of a condition attached to this consent, you might be entitled to recover compensation from the Council. If you wish to make a claim you must do so



within 12 months from the date of this decision (or, if you appeal to the Secretary of State, within 12 months from the date of this decision).
