## FELL AND GRIND TREE STUMP OF A TREE PROTECTED BY A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER LAND OPPOSITE 6 OAKLANDS, BECKERMET, EGREMONT

FELL AND GRIND TREE STUMP OF A TREE PROTECTED BY A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

The felled oak tree is to be replaced during the first available planting season following the work. Plant the new tree, a 6-8cm girth, light standard Sessile Oak (Quercus petraea), within 3m of the felled tree it replaces, or another size, species, location or period as agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority. If the replacement tree dies, becomes diseased, or is damaged within 5 years of the date it is planted it must be replaced in the next available planting season by another of a similar size and species.

## Reason

To ensure the continuity of amenity in accordance with 'Policy DM28 – Protection of Trees' of the Copeland Local Plan 2013-2028.
