The felled trees must be replaced during the first planting season following the work, with 1x Apple (Malus) species and 1x Olive (Olea), within the curtilage of the property. Alternatively, another size and species, location, or period should be agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority. If a replacement tree dies, gets diseased, or is damaged within 5 years of the date of planting, it must be replaced in the next available planting season by another of a similar size and species.
