- 1. Carry out all pruning work in accordance with BS3998:2010 Tree work Recommendations section 7.7 'Crown reduction and reshaping'.
- Crown reduction branch pruning is limited to a maximum crown height reduction of 1.5m and lateral branch reduction of 1m. Crown lift pruning is limited to a maximum of 5m clearance over the road. This is to restrict the volume of crown reduction and minimise the impact to the tree's health.
- 3. All crown reduction pruning operations are limited to a maximum branch diameter of 50mm. This is to restrict the volume of crown reduction and minimise the impact to the tree's health.

Reason

In accordance with Section 198 of the 1990 Town and Country Planning Act and in the interest of good arboricultural practice.

I have attached a copy of the Council's Consultant Arboriculturalist's Report for your information.

Your Right of Appeal

If you disagree with our decision you can appeal to The Planning Inspectorate, Environment and Transport Team, 3/A Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol, BS1 6PN within 28 days from the date you received this decision.

Compensation

If you suffer any loss or damage as a result of a condition attached to this consent, you might be entitled to recover compensation from the Council. If you wish to make a claim you must do so within 12 months from the date of this decision (or, if you appeal to the Secretary of State, within 12 months from the date of this decision).
