We have no objections to the proposed development, however we wish to make the following comments:-

We have reviewed the application and supporting information, including the Ecological Impact Assessment (referenced: 5226193, revision 1.3; dated 19/04/2024) and Design and Access Statement (referenced: PLC_BCC_2219), both prepared by Sellafield Ltd.

We have no concerns in regard to long term impacts upon the groundwater environment. It should be noted that a groundwater investigation consent is unlikely to be required based on the proposals, as there is no mention of abstracting form the boreholes. However, if there is a plan to abstract greater than 20 cubic metres per day, an abstraction license and/or a groundwater investigation consent may be needed.
