- Hydrocarbon Contamination Assessment, Prepared by GEO Environmental Engineering July 2024, received by the Local Planning Authority on the 31st July 2024.

Decision of Council

Pursuant to the above, it is confirmed that the requirements of planning condition 8 attached to the planning permission reference 4/17/2143/0F1 are <u>discharged in part only</u>. To fully discharge this condition a Validation Report will need to be submitted and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

I would advise that condition 12 still requires discharge prior to the commencement of any works at the site. Conditions 6 and 11 also require discharge prior to the occupation of the development.
