4 - Ash to fell, dying.	
5 - Weening ash to fell dead	

- 5 Weeping ash to fell, dead.
- 6 Ash to fell, rotten base cause danger.
- 7 Ash to fell, rotten base causing danger.
- 8 Sycamore to fell, dying.'
