**PRUNING OF BRANCH OFF OAK TREE PROTECTED BY A TREE PRESERVATION  
ORDER  
MELSUNGEN, RHEDA PARK, FRIZINGTON**

<i>'T1. Oak. Lateral branch has split leaving part of the branch supported on the floor and a large tear out wound closer to the union. Propose pruning off the branch to make safe.'</i>
